Arthur L. Garnes, M.D.

- First board-certified Black plastic surgeon in the country
- Wasn't allowed to sit for the ABPS Certifying exam would eventually be 'grandfathered in.'
- First Black director of a plastic surgery program in the U.S.
- Oversaw the first approved plastic surgery residency to exist at a predominantly Black hospital.
- Devoted his practice to the care of the often overlooked, inner-city patients.
- After retirement, moved with wife Vivian to Maryland where he served as a minister and mentor.
